



Health Assistance for immigrants in Italy

- Regular immigrants can register with the National Health Service in order to have the same rights of Italian citizens;
- Irregular immigrants can have access to health care services by the code STP (straniero temporaneamente presente temporarily present foreigner);
- Citizens of the new EU Members States who are not registered with the National Health Service can have access to health care services by the code ENI (europeo non iscritto - European citizens not registered with the National Health Service).

Health Services Orientation Centre for Immigrants (COSSI)

Immigrants needing to know where they can be treated or how they can carry out the necessary procedures, can turn to the Health Services Orientation Centre for Immigrants (COSSI). There they will find ASL employees and language and cultural mediators.

COSSI is located in Cagliari at the Cittadella della Salute, via Romagna 16, within the Health Promotion Service, pavilion D, first floor

Out-patient Department for Temporarily Present Foreigners

Irregular immigrants and the citizens of the new EU Members States who are not registered with the National Health Service needing treatments, can turn to the STP Out-patient Department for Temporarily Present Foreigners. There they will find doctors, nurses and cultural mediators.

The STP Out-patient Department is located in Cagliari at the General Outpatients' clinic in Viale Trieste 37/b, fourth floor.

Hours: Tuesday and Thursday from 3 to 6 pm.

The free services offered by the STP Out-patient Department are:

- medical examinations;
- issue of the code STP (Temporarily Present Foreigner);
- issue of the code ENI (European citizen not registered with the National Health Service);
- aid of foreign cultural mediators.
